MASTERING THE AUDIT OF A MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR RECORDS (MSR) BASED ON ISO 30301

SUMMARY

This five-day intensive course enables participants to develop the necessary expertise to audit a Management System for Records (QMS) based on ISO 30301 and to manage a team of auditors by applying widely recognized audit principles, procedures and techniques. During this training, the participant will acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to proficiently plan and perform internal and external audits in compliance with ISO 19011; the certification process according to ISO 17021. Based on practical exercises, the participant will develop the skills (mastering audit techniques) and competencies (managing audit teams and audit program, communicating with customers, conflict resolution, etc.) necessary to efficiently conduct an audit.

EXAMINATION

The “PECB Certified ISO 30301 Lead Auditor” exam fully meets the requirements of the PECB Examination and Certification Programme (ECP). The exam covers the following competence domains:

1 Domain 1: Fundamental principles of records management

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor candidate can understand, interpret and illustrate the main Records Management concepts related to a Management System for Records (MSR))

2 Domain 2: Management System for Records (MSR)

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor candidate can understand, interpret and illustrate the main concepts and components of a Management System for Records based on ISO 30301

3 Domain 3: Fundamental concepts and principles of auditing

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor candidate can understand, interpret and apply the main concepts and principles related to a MSR audit in the context of ISO 30301

4 Domain 4: Preparation of an ISO 30301 audit

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor candidate can prepare appropriately a MSR audit in the context of ISO 30301

5 Domain 5: Conducting an ISO 30301 audit

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor candidate can conduct efficiently a MSR audit in the context of ISO 30301

6 Domain 6: Concluding an ISO 30301 audit

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor candidate can conclude a MSR audit, and conduct the follow-up activities in the context of ISO 30301

7 Domain 7: Managing an ISO 30301 audit program

Main Objective: To ensure that the ISO 30301 Lead Auditor understands how to establish and manage a MSR audit program

CERTIFICATION

- ▶ After successfully completing the exam, participants can apply for the credentials of PECB Certified ISO 30301 Provisional Auditor, PECB Certified ISO 30301 Auditor or PECB Certified ISO 30301 Lead Auditor depending on their level of experience. Those credentials are available for internal and external auditors
- ▶ A certificate will be issued to participants who successfully pass the exam and comply with all the other requirements related to the selected credential.
